

During the month of August, Amy Rieg will display her works of art in the McCloud Campus Center Art Gallery on the Founders Campus.



Amy is an award-winning photographer and encaustic artist who lives and works in Lancaster. She lived most of her adult life in Colorado and when her husband lost his job of 19 years, they moved to Pennsylvania to live with family and return to school. She graduated with highest honors from HACC with an AFA in Photography in December 2018. Amy is fortunate enough to have become part of the lineage of photographers who have learned from the great masters. Her mentors Ronald Talbot and Garrick Dorsett had personal learning experiences with Sally Mann, Owen Butler, Minor White, and Ansel Adams, who learned from the photographic pioneers, Alfred Stieglitz and Edward Steichen. She is now attending Millersville University and pursuing a teaching degree in art education.

Amy says, "Light surrounds us, and as a photographer, I capture that light and interpret it in different ways. I love presenting my art on traditional prints and canvases. But I was able to elevate my art to a new level when I found encaustic photography. Adding wax to an image can create a sense of mystery, romanticize the light, or produce excitement through the texture. My hope is to give my audience something they've never seen before and instill an appreciation of things that often go overlooked in addition to observing our world in a different way."
