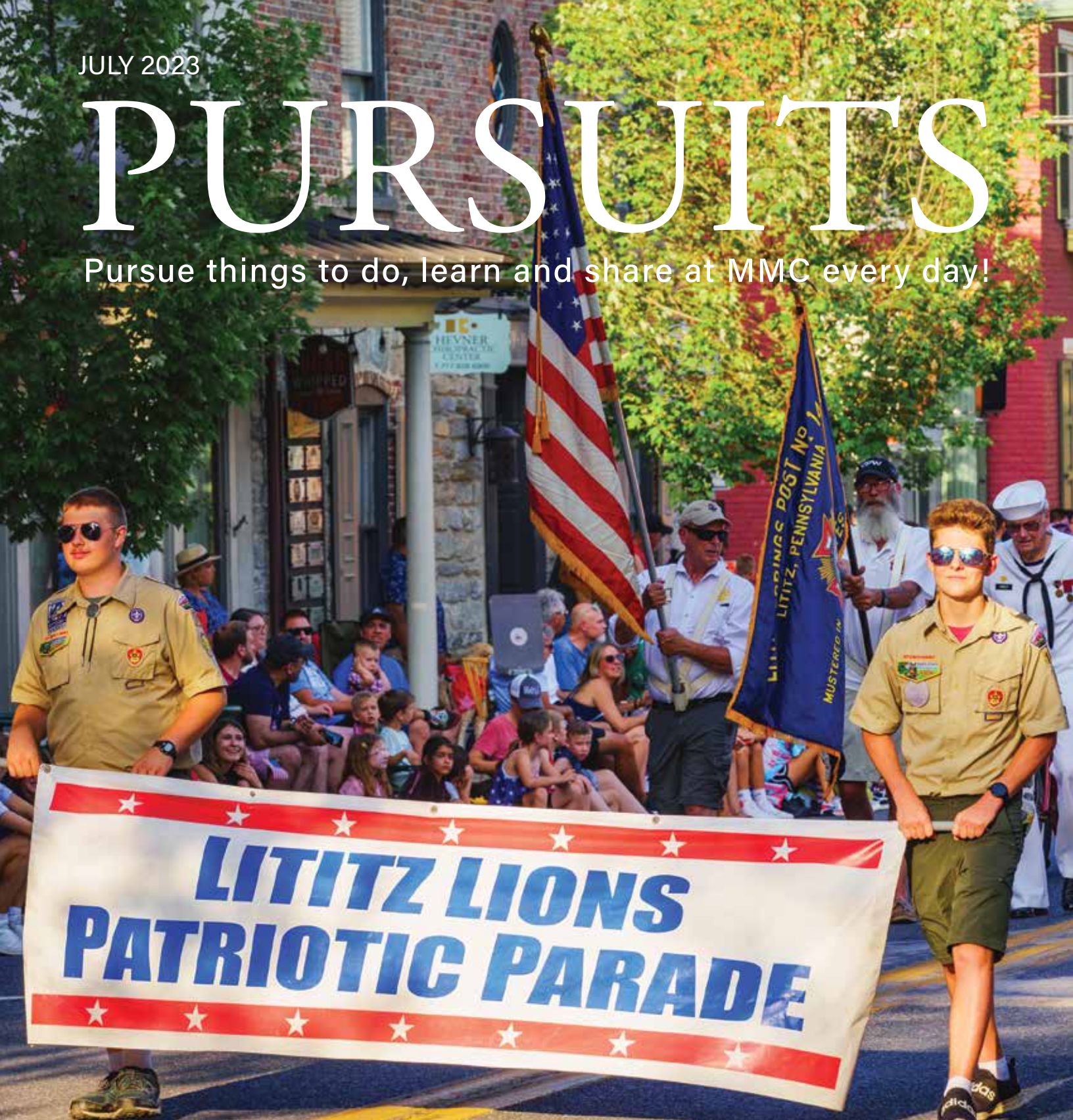

Trash Talk

The Trash Talk Team received an inquiry as to "why should we separate household trash and recyclables when they are both dumped into the same trash truck?" This is an accurate observation as both household trash and recyclables are disposed of in the same truck.



Recently the Trash Talk Team toured the Lancaster County Solid Waste Management Authority facilities, LCSWMA, in Lancaster. While on our tour, we posed this question to the LCWSMA personnel. They told us that Waste Management has now replaced their old trash trucks with new trucks which have two separate compartments as shown below. The larger compartment on the right is for household waste and the smaller compartment on the left is for recyclables.

There are several advantages brought about by the new trucks. The most visible to Moravian Manor residents is there is only one trash truck going down our streets on trash day. The larger advantage is the financial savings for Waste Management and their customers is the cost savings in the reduction of trash trucks and their associated purchase and operational expenses. There is also the reduction in staffing which as we evidenced last year has been a major problem for Waste Management.
